Route:

Our starting point will once again be the Gulf side of the Sanibel Bridge. Boats should assemble around 10:45am and we will leave by 11:00 Sharp. To make this run a little more fun than an upriver jaunt we will run the outside of Sanibel in the Gulf of America to red fish pass. We will then go through red fish pass and run the ICW to the no wake zone at the mouth of the Caloosahatchee River continuing up river to Three Fisherman. A If you are not comfortable running in the gulf feel free to run the ICW up to red fish pass to meet us and run back in the ICW.

In addition while at lunch we will talk about a possible raft up for anyone that is interested.

NOTE: THE NO WAKE SIGNS ARE BACK IN FRONT OF GULF HARBOUR AND THEY ARE ENFORCING IT HARD!

Dockage:

Three Fishermen has a ton of beautiful floating docks. We will have to raft off some but nearly as much as we typically do.

Fuel/Distance:

From the Sanibel bridge to Redfish Pass, back through the ICW and upriver to Three Fishermen is about 50 miles. Fuel is available on the River at the Landing's just west of the Cape Coral Bridge.

Food:

Three Fisherman will have a limited but diverse menu for us. We will have their entire banquet room as well as any open seating around the restaurant and deck.

Communication:

Safety:

Each boat captain is required to operate his vessel in a safe manner and is responsible for his/her crew and their safety. When running in the ICW please be aware that this can be a high traffic area and we ask that other boats be given a wide berth and that the rules of the road be adhered to. As always please no alcohol for the captains. Our event is concluded upon reaching our lunch destination. Everyone can leave when they are ready
